“C” level clubs :- Barrow, Burnley, Chorley, Leigh, Rossendale

“D” level clubs :- Kendal, Lytham

“E” level clubs :- Knowsley

“A” size clubs to provide 5 officials, 2 of which must be graded to minimum level 2

“B” size clubs to provide 4 officials, 2 of which must be graded to minimum level 2

“C” size clubs to provide 3 officials, 1 of which must be graded to minimum level 2

“D” size clubs to provide 2 officials, 1 of which must be graded to minimum level 2

“E” size clubs do not need to provide any officials

Club sizes will be reviewed at the end of the season and any changes will be notified at the AGM to take effect in the following season. Information from the previous 2 seasons will be used.

Failure to provide the required number and level of officials at more than one of the six meetings will result in the club involved being fined £30 for every missing graded official and £10 for every missing ungraded official.
